1	<p><b>Chairman's Introduction:</b> The Chairman formally opened the meeting by welcoming the 17 Trust members present and thanked them for taking the time to attend. He then read out the main aims of the Trust which are published on the website <a href="http://www.thelinnets.co.uk">www.thelinnets.co.uk</a>. He then pointed out that for the first time since the Trust was formed, these main aims had been achieved. This was mainly due to the new owners wishing to engage with the Trust. It is now hoped that the relationship with TSI can be further developed.</p>

	Dr Robert Britton and Matthew Lane to serve for a further 3 years as Trust Directors. Votes for were 17, and there were no votes against, therefore Robert and Matthew were duly re-elected.

<b>7.</b>	<b>Closure of the Meeting:</b> The Chairman again thanked those present for their attendance and contribution to the meeting. The meeting was closed at 7:39pm.  NB: The floor was then opened for questions to the Board and general discussion.	

Some of the questions raised post-meeting were:

Q. What is the Trust relationship like with TSI?

A. The Chairman was not in a position to give a definitive answer, but reiterated what was said at the recent fans' forum. TSI do not see themselves as being here for the long term, but will be here for multiple seasons.
