

Minutes of the Blue and Gold Trust meeting held on 27th April 2013 at the Crown and Mitre

1. Apologies for absence were received from L.Rout.
2. The minutes of the previous meeting were read, agreed, and signed as a true record.
3. It was agreed that we have the potential to increase the revenue from advertising on the website and that this could be maximised by employing somebody on a commission only basis. Efforts will be made to appoint an appropriate person. The Trust will also be collaborating with other groups on a variety of fundraising initiatives over the coming months.
4. Adult membership stands at 93.
5. Draw 37 of the Lotto was made with the winners being posted on the forum as soon as possible. Entries stand at 185.
6. The Treasurer produced an up to date income and expenditure account, a copy of which was posted on the forum.
7. The South Lynn Sports Club which is organised by the Trust and funded by grant money continues to develop. Saturday morning football sessions attract up to 18 youngsters and the first Monday evening session held on the 22nd April was enjoyed by 35 youngsters aged from 6 to 15. Additionally the Trust, again using grant money, has paid for two 18 year olds to attend a County FA level 1 coaching course which is being held at Terrington during half term week in May. We are also running a tennis ‘ taster ‘ session at St. Michaels school during half term with a view to running tennis sessions on a Thursday evening during the summer months. The meeting confirmed arrangements for the Trust to assist with the organisation of the GEAR 10k run which is being held on Sunday 5th May. Four committee members will put out the course signs early in the morning and will then be joined by others to man the baggage tent during the race itself.
8. The Supporters Direct AGM is being held at St.Georges Park, Burton on 22nd June and it is intended that the Trust will be represented. The Localism Act which was introduced in 2011 is now active.
9. AOB JG reported that our Data Protection renewal is due shortly. It was confirmed that the Trust would continue its sponsorship of the U8 age group award at KLCF.
